

Antacid Gel

Feed additives for animals in gel

COMPOSITION:

Natural components:

- Greek seed
- Mac grass
- Ginger
- Lavender oil
- Peppermint oil

Trace elements:

- Aluminum
- Magnesium

Preservatives and solvents:

- Baking soda
- Xanthan gum
- Purified water

USE:

Antacid Gel is a complex of dry extracts, essential oils of plants and inorganic compounds that neutralize hydrochloric acid in gastric juice. It is used to prevent all pathological changes in the gastrointestinal tract aimed at reducing hydrochloric acid and increasing the pH of the stomach, as well as alleviating pain in gastritis, peptic ulcer.

TARGET SPECIES: Dogs and cats

DOSAGE:

Antacid gel should be administered to the animal between meals or with a meal.

By pushing out the contents of the syringe into the mouth in the required daily doses.

Dogs and cats: 1ml/5kg of body weight, 2-3 times a day, 3-5 days.

Animals that have less than 5kg of body weight, the dose is 1ml.

ADVERSE REACTION: None

WITHDRAWAL PERIOD: None

SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS: Store in a dry and cool place protected from humidity and light. Keep away from children. Keep in closed containers.
